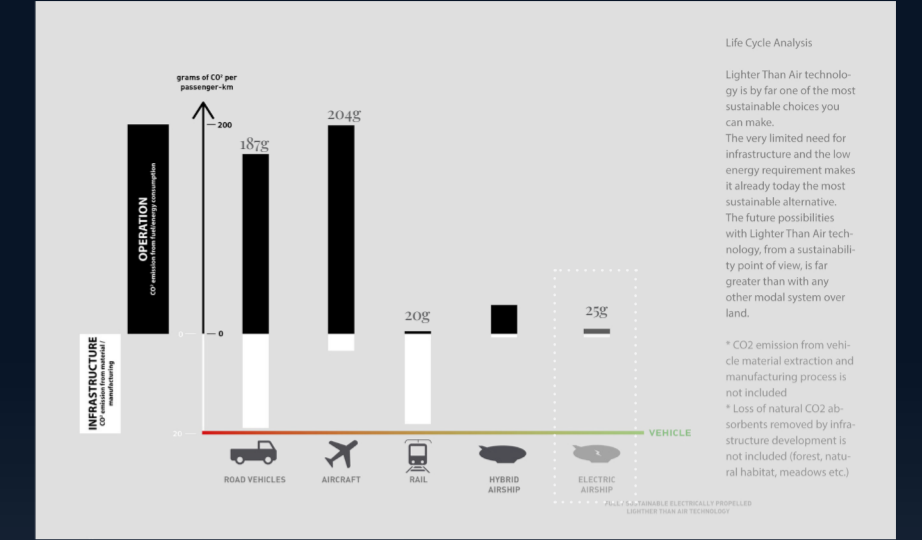

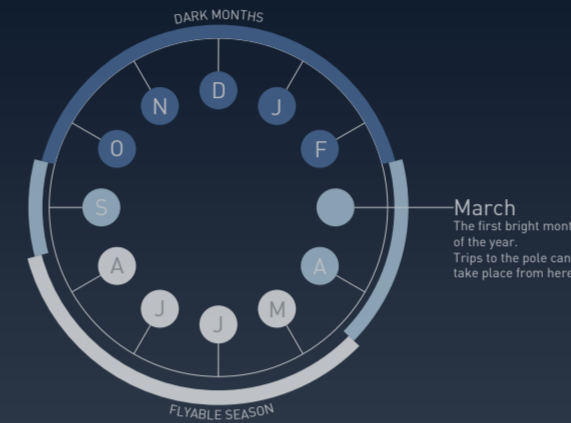


The Airship

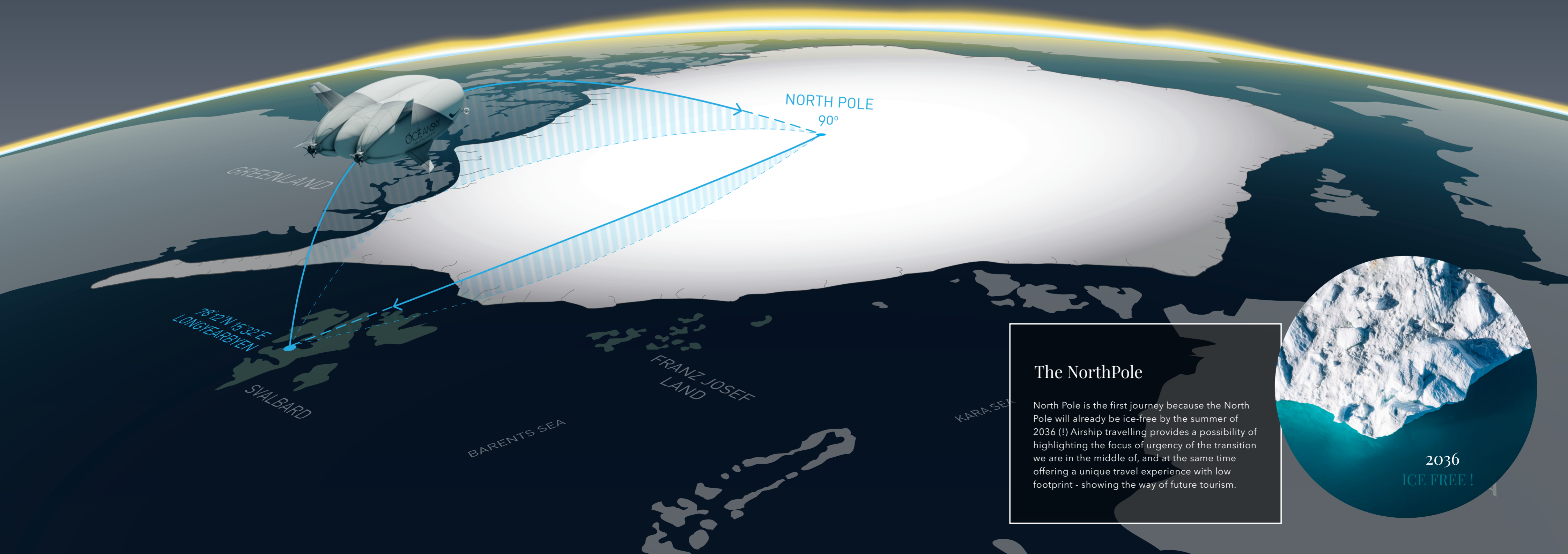
Much development has happened over the last 90 years. New material innovations and new methods of lifting in other ways than using flammable hydrogen. Today only helium is allowed. This, together with a demand for new greener transport forms is why 5-10 airship developers and manufacturers are at levels ranging from prototypes to operation. Airships can provide access to remote place without the need of infrastructure. The Oceansky Project collaborate with British airship producer (Hybrid Air Vehicles).

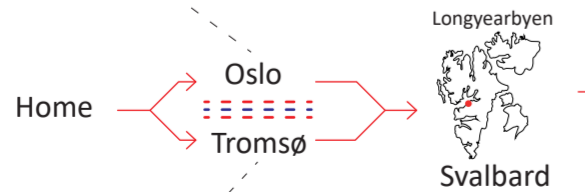

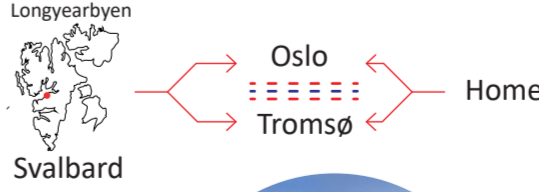


Both SAS and Norwegian fly to Svalbard. You can choose direct flight from Oslo or from Tromsø (SAS).
