## Zoox Robotaxi on Public Roads: A World's First

Built with no steering wheel or pedals, this is the first time in history a purpose-built autonomous robotaxi has carried passengers on public roads.

<b>MILESTONE</b>	First-time in history a purpose-built autonomous robotaxi has carried passengers on public roads.
<b>LOCATION</b>	Foster City, California
<b>ABOUT THE ROUTE</b>	<p>One mile per direction, connecting between two main buildings at Zoox headquarters.</p> <p>Our vehicle can transport up to four people at a time on a public route between two Zoox office buildings, can travel up to 35 mph, and navigates left-hand and right-hand turns, bidirectional turns, traffic lights, bicyclists, pedestrians, vehicles, and other road agents on this route.</p>
<b>WHEN</b>	On February 11, 2023, we conducted our maiden run of our employee shuttle service in our purpose-built robotaxi, built without a steering wheel or pedals.
<b>WHO IS ELIGIBLE</b>	This initial service is exclusive to Zoox employees.
<b>COST</b>	This service is provided exclusively to Zoox employees, and we will not charge a fare.
<b>SAFETY DRIVERS</b>	This is the first-time in history that an autonomous, purpose-built, FMVSS-compliant robotaxi is on public roads without a safety driver.
<b>PERMITS</b>	Zoox secured an extension to its California Driverless permit to give us the proper regulatory authorization to test drive our purpose-built vehicles on public roads.
<b>WHAT'S NEXT</b>	This marks the first test run of our employee shuttle service in our headquarters of Foster City, California, with our employee shuttle service to launch soon.
